MACINTOSH TROPHY

Competition Rules

1. The competition shall consist of: -

Singles 21 shots

Pairs 17 ends

Triples 15 ends

Fours 15 ends

1 trial end can be played if required

2. All players must be aged 60 years or more on the date of the competition

3. Teams may consist of Ladies and Gents

4. No club will play on their own green, clubs hosting matches should supply a marker for the singles and an umpire

5. 2 points will be awarded to the winner of each individual game, total 8 points, if two or more teams have the same points then shots difference will decide, then if still tied then ends won will decide the winner.

6. If a club turns up in either the singles, pairs or triples with less than the required number of players then the opposing team will be awarded 2 points plus 2 shots. In the fours, if only 3 players are available, they will be allowed to play but will be deducted 25% of their score.

7. If a green is deemed unplayable and an alternative green is not available then both teams will agree to play their game as soon as possible in the following week on the same green.

8. All games will commence at 2.00 pm. 30 minutes grace will be given if a team turns up after 2.30 that team will be disqualified and 2 points and 2 shots will be awarded to their opposition.

9. Dress Code, registered club colours or black trousers and white shirts to be worn.

9. Clubs should leave their cards with the umpire of the club hosting the tie who should pass it to the club's delegate and then phone results to Jim McKenzie on 07771641670 or email them to jimimac797@gmail.com as soon as possible after the conclusion of their games.

Clubs should retain the cards for 2 weeks after the game before disposal.
